## **WHEN ARE THE VICTORIAN WALKS?**

Victorian Walks are always the 1st and 2nd Saturdays in December.

There is no cover charge for the Walks, however many local businesses will be offering specials during these evenings. Businesses and vendors set their own prices, and it is the perfect opportunity to find those perfect gifts for your loved ones and sample some truly delectable local food and drink!

## **DO WE HAVE TO DRESS UP/CAN WE DRESS UP?**
